8th grade is rewarded with a breakfast after constant work in making their davnening the most meaningful time of

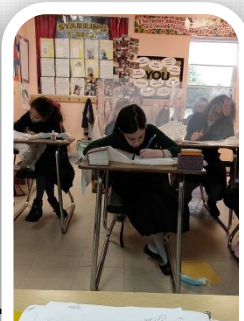
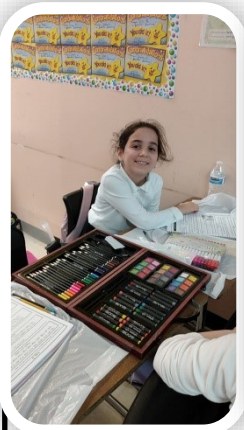
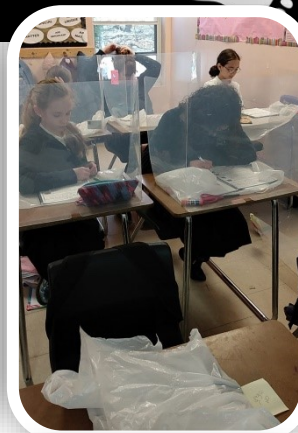

Rosie Ives—Grade 6

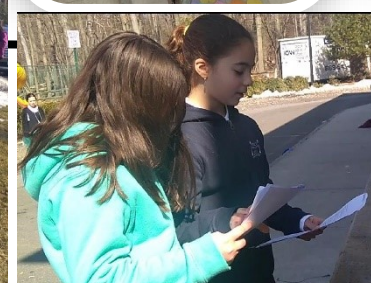
Between the leaves of the wood,
