Thus, the Ten Commandments, which include within them the entire Torah, will become a part of our lives throughout the entire year."

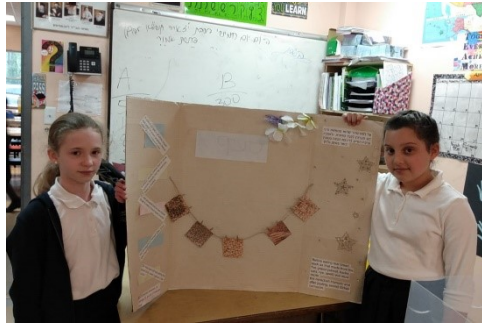
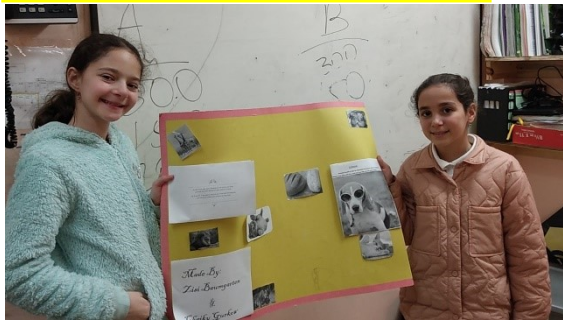
