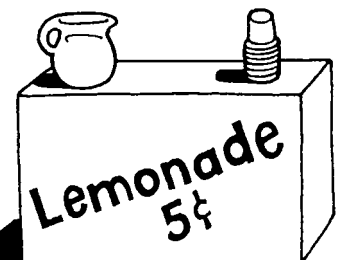
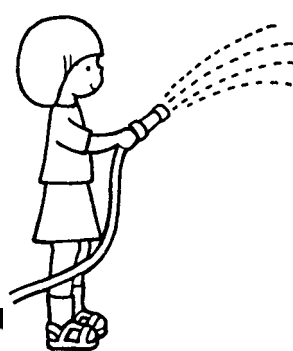
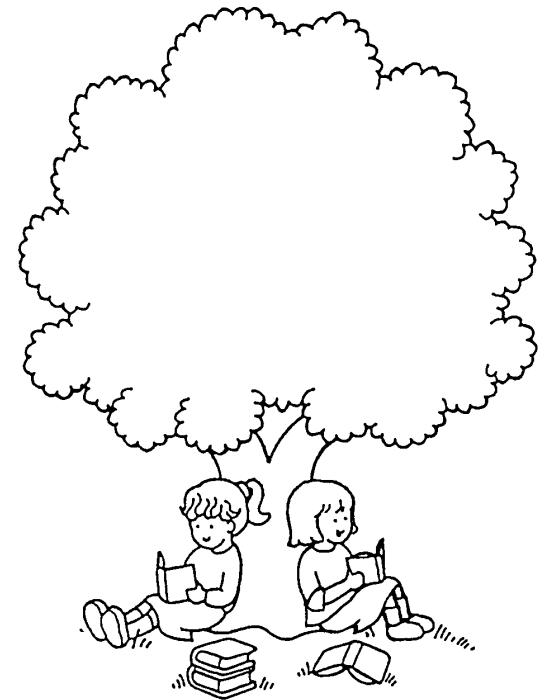
In this way, you will — together with learning new physical powers — generate fresh spiritual powers. The two together, and particularly the spiritual powers, will make a person complete and healthy.

With blessings for a healthy summer — in both a material and spiritual sense,

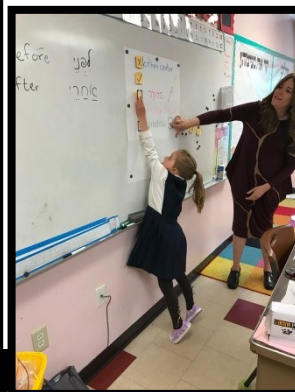
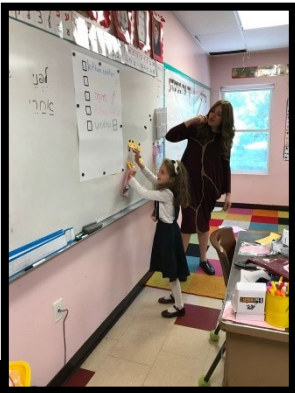
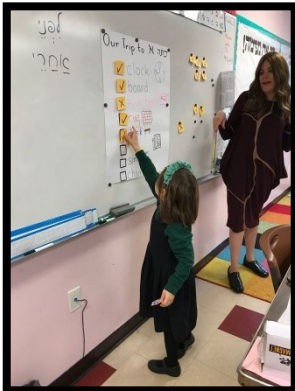

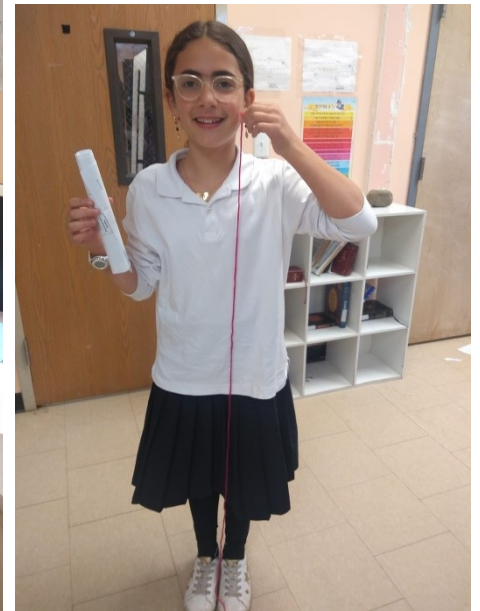
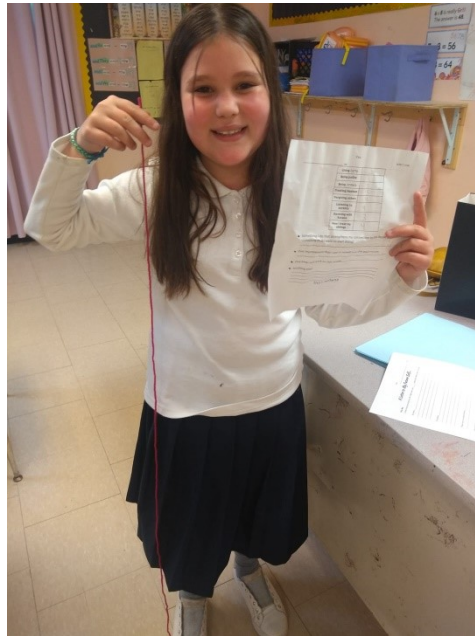


# 4<sup>th</sup> GRADE

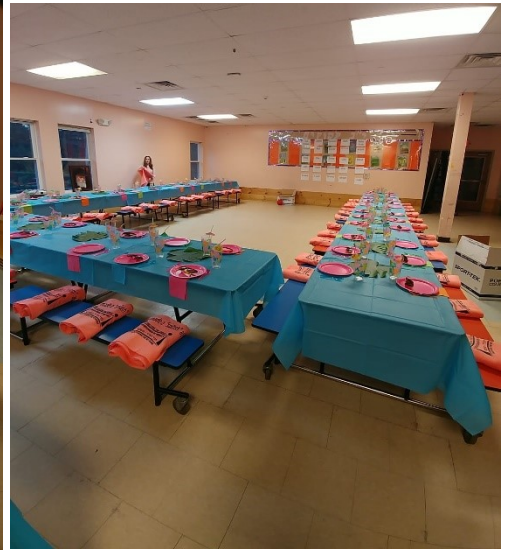
