PreSchool News

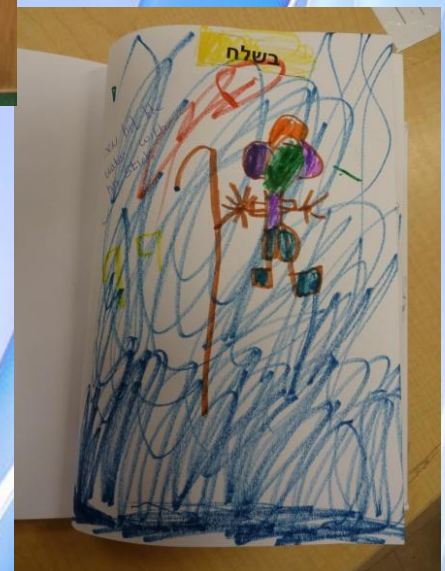
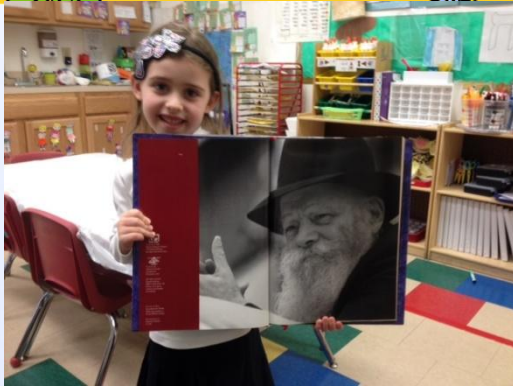

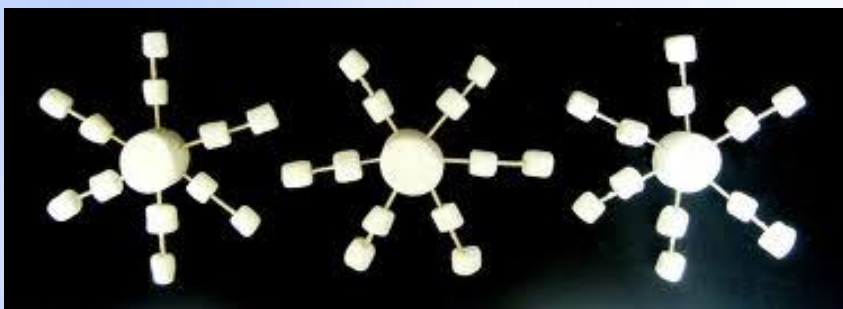


FIRST GRADE WINTER UPDATE
