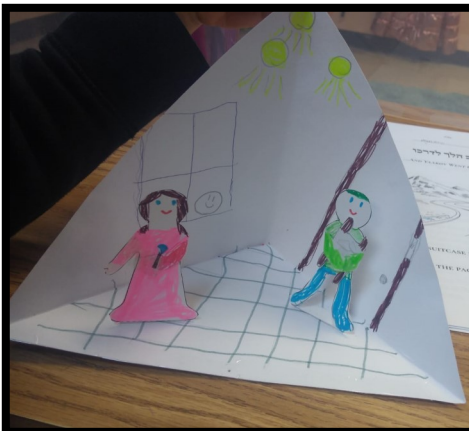
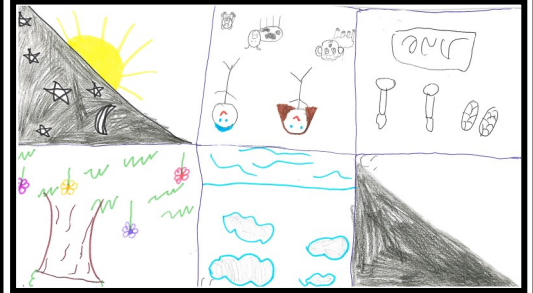
4TH GRADE

In all the preschool classes this week the Kinderlach learned all about Hashem's beautiful world.

There were many discussions on explaining how the year is a cycle and about starting the first ספר. We were able to go outside and explore so many of Hashem's creations, with help from the glorious weather this week!

In preschool we started our first Science session with Morah Koror:

Our science lesson this week was connected to the סוכה on the sukkah. We learned that pine comes from pine trees and the pine trees are evergreen trees. Ask your child what evergreen means (they all referenced to the supermarket!). Everyone loved learning the lifecycle of a pine tree and exploring pine cones. They explored a pinecone close in water. The pinecones close in water to protect the seed from falling out in wet weather. At the right time the pinecones fall off the trees and the wind animals spread their seeds so new pine trees can grow. The students came up with great ideas for why we need trees ; for shade, to get food, for paper, for air and for wood to build. What a bright bunch!
