Dear Parents,

In 5741, the Rebbe instituted Tzivos Hashem to add chayus to the Hakhel campaign. It was then that he penned a letter to children and addressed the inaugural Tzivos Hashem rally. In those years, children had the zechus of hearing their directives directly from the Rebbe.

Today our children rely on us to inspire them. Chayolei Tzivos Hashem is a valuable resource in helping that happen.

The registration fee for the year is \$60. It is a one-time fee, which includes weekly mission sheets, monthly rallies, promotions, prizes, a subscription to Hachayol magazine, and a Tzivos Hashem Gift (contingent on doing missions for a certain number of weeks.)

To subscribe, follow the steps below.

- 1. Create an account on <u>mashpia.com/mobile</u> via your browser or the Tzivos Hashem app. If your family has registered previously, simply log on with your user.
- 2. For a child who has been registered previously, click the "register" button near their name. For a child who has not yet registered previously, click "add child."
- 3. Enter all relevant information in the fields. Double-check that all details are correct, as the information will be used for promotions, Hachayol, and certificates throughout the year.
- 4. Feel free to reach out with any questions thgirls@chedermonsey.org.
- 5. It's recommended to join the WhatsApp group only for updates and useful and important information. Only admins can write so that it doesn't get too many messages per day. https://chat.whatsapp.com/ LaaRLSQ8sdPliXhtwGeK7H
- 6. Chidon will be launched and announced for grades 5-8 next week. (Girls who want to join chidon can do so independently without signing up for the Tzivos Hashem program itself.)
