CHEDER CHABAD STANDARDS

Cheder Chabad strives to educate Chassidishe children with proper middos, dedicated to Torah and Mitzvos. This obviously requires a strong partnership between home and school. It is therefore our goal to uphold a respectful and cooperative relationship between both. It is imperative that our children receive a clear and unified message. We trust that the standards and expectations in the home reflect that of a Chabad mosad.

PARENT DRESS CODE

All parents are expected to adhere to the following Halachic standards at all times.

- Necklines need to cover the collarbone.
- Sleeves need to be **covering the elbow.**
- Skirts need to cover the knees at all times.
- Stockings or tights need to be worn. Leggings and socks are not acceptable.
- Married women must have their hair **completely** covered.
- Men must wear *yarmulkas*, a shirt and pants (*No shorts*).

All parents participating in <u>any</u> school function, including carpool, whether on or off Cheder premises, must be properly dressed according to *Halacha*. Please do not enter Cheder if you do not adhere to the standards outlined above.

VISITOR DRESS CODE

Friends or relatives who wish to participate in school functions should respectfully comply with our school dress code.

KASHRUS

All food sent to school must have a chassidishe hechsher or an <u>Yisroel</u>, <u>Snacks need to be Pas Yisroel</u>, <u>Bishul Yisroel</u>, <u>and Cholov Yisroel</u>. All drinks, with natural or artificial flavoring must have kosher supervision. Home baked goods may never be shared with classmates.

WHATSAPP GROUPS

Whatsapp groups can be an accessible means for parents to stay updated on happenings and events in your child's classroom. Beyond that, a public WhatsApp group is not the forum to resolve a personal issue or air a grievance. It causes unnecessary loshon hora and damage that could have otherwise been dealt with in an appropriate manner.

Procedures

Preschool hours

Pre-Nursery:

Monday- Thursday: 9:15 a.m. – 2:45 p.m. Friday: 9:15 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Nursery and UPK:

Monday- Thursday: 9:15 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Friday: 9:15 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Pre-1A:

Monday- Thursday: 9:15 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Friday: 9:15 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.

Pre-1A Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival for Carpool

School begins at 9:15 a.m. Prompt arrival provides a positive beginning for your child's school day. For parents driving children to school- please drop your children off at school between 9:00 and 9:15 a.m. During these fifteen minutes, an assistant will be waiting outside the door facing South Monsey Road, to greet your child and to accompany/guide him/her to his/her classroom. Parents or carpools that arrive late to school (past 9:15 a.m.), must park their cars in the parking lot and walk their child to the classroom.

Cheder Chabad Preschool cannot take responsibility for students before 9:00 a.m.

Arrival for Bus Riders

At the beginning of the year an assistant will be waiting outside at the bus arrival location to bring children to their classrooms.

Dismissal

Dismissal for all students begins at 3:45 p.m. The children are escorted to their bus line. If you are picking up your child, please wait in the carpool lane and your child will be waiting at the South Monsey door and will be called out when your car pulls up.

Pre1A Dismissal changes

For any dismissal changes, i.e. your child will be picked up instead of going on the bus, it is imperative you send a clear note with your child for the teacher. Please don't give a verbal message to your child without sending a note to the teacher as that causes a lot of confusion.

The school cannot take responsibility for any last minute carpool changes by phone. **If you have an emergency dismissal change only**, make sure that you call the office as early on in the day as possible.

Early Learning Center Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival

School begins at 9:15 a.m. Prompt arrival provides a positive beginning for your child's school day. For parents driving children to school- please drop off children at school by 9:15 a.m. Starting at 9:00 an assistant will be waiting outside the door, to greet your child and to accompany him/her to his/her classroom. Parents or carpools that arrive late to school (past 9:15 a.m.), must park their cars in the parking lot and walk their child to the classroom.

Cheder Chabad Preschool cannot take responsibility for students before 9:00 a.m. unless it is prearranged with our early care teacher.

Dismissal

Dismissal begins at 2:30 for Prenursery and at 2:45 p.m. for Nursery and UPK, and runs until 2:45 p.m. for Prenursery and 3:00 p.m. for Nursery and UPK. Your child will be escorted to your car once you arrive and circle around the building. Parents arriving before or after these times for dismissal must park in the parking lot and walk into the school. Please pick up your child promptly to help us have a smooth dismissal. *Please ensure you are on time to pick up your preschool child/children. Parents will be charged a \$10 fee for late pickup per occurrence.*

Extended Day Option

We will be providing an extended day option for those who need. It will run from 2:45-4:00 for prenursery and 3:00-4:00 for nursery and UPK. There will be an additional half hour from 4:00-4:30 for those who need for an additional \$3 per day. To participate in the extended day option, ten head checks of \$70 for each month of school will be required in advance. If you will be using the 4:00-4:30 option, the additional fee is \$420 for the year. The fee for a one time use of the extended day option 3:00-4:00 is \$10 per day.

Dismissal changes

When calling during the day to leave change of dismissal information, please do <u>not</u> leave a message on the school office machine. If there is no answer, please email <u>preschool@chedermonsey.org</u>, to ensure that we get the information promptly.

Snack/Lunch

Our preschool encourages healthy eating habits. We allow only healthy snacks to be brought to school. A list of some healthy snack ideas follows. This list is not exhaustive-it is meant to give you some ideas.

<u>All preschool classes</u> should bring a Ha'etz or Ha'adoma snack for the morning and a healthy snack for the afternoon. Any unhealthy snack will be sent back home with a note, and replaced with a healthy snack.

Following are some ideas for healthy snacks.

- Yogurt
- Cheese- American cheese, string cheese, cottage cheese
- Fresh fruit- apple, banana, clementine, grapes, nectarine, pear
- Dried fruit- apricots, apples, mango, raisins
- Applesauce
- Cut fresh vegetables- carrots, celery, cucumbers, peppers, tomatoes
- Crackers- graham crackers, thin wheats
- Rice cakes, corn cakes, soy crisps
- Pretzels
- Breadsticks
- Dry cereal
- Popcorn

Tuesday is Fleishig lunch. Please do not send in a Milchig snack on Tuesdays.

Allergies

If your child has any allergies (food or other) or other medical needs, it is imperative to let us know before school starts. The more information we have about your child, the better able we will be to meet their needs.

Please note that Cheder Chabad is a **NUT FREE FACILITY**, please do not send any food or snacks that can put a child with a food allergy in danger.

Birthday Celebrations

If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday at school you may do so. Please adhere to the following preschool birthday party guidelines.

- 1- Please reserve the date with the classroom teacher at least one week in advance.
- 2- The celebration takes place for about twenty minutes, during a time arranged with the classroom teacher.
- 3- Please send in mini cupcakes. If you wish to bring a drink, please bring grape juice for L'chaim. For everyone's *kashrus* comfort, home baked goods should not be brought in. Should you have any questions, please feel free to call the preschool director, Mrs. Light.
- **4-** "Peklach" are not distributed in our preschool at birthday celebrations. In lieu of "peklach" and excessive snack foods, you may donate a book or educational game/toy to the class in honor of your child's birthday. Please reach out to your child's teacher to inquire about the classroom wish list.

Uniform

PRE NURSERY, NURSERY & UPK

Pre-Nursery, Nursery and UPK do not have an official school uniform. Please ensure your child's clothing reflects the Cheder Chabad tznius standards.

For Nursery and UPK – All girls must wear tights and have covered elbows and knees at all times.

All students must wear closed toes shoes (no crocs or sandals).

Biting Policy

In small children, biting is a developmentally appropriate behavior. However, by the time a child is in Pre-1A, this is no longer appropriate. Any Pre-1A child who bites another child will have his parent called and he will have to be picked up for the remainder of the day.

Toilet Training

Pre-Nursery:

In the Pre-Nursery classes, teachers can help facilitate a child's toilet training. However, if a child has continuous accidents, it may result in the use of a diaper or pull up.

Nursery:

All children coming in to Nursery must be completely toilet trained before the start of the school year. If your child is not trained, we will hold his/her spot until after Yom Tov.
