LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

"Every Yid is a fire". This week's *parshah*, Beha'alosecho, opens with the special mitzvah Hashem of kindling the Menorah. Chassidus provides us with a deep insight about this mitzvah and explains that the Menorah represents all Yidden, because the purpose of every Yid is to be a *neir lehoir*. The Rebbe repeated the words *neir lehoir hundreds of times along with the words שתהא שלהבת עולה מאלי*, "that once we are kindled by Ahron, we should burn independently and be able to ignite others."

Children may feel that they don't have the power to change the world or even to illuminate a small corner of it. They may feel that their role is only to receive, to listen, to sit quietly and absorb as much as they can.

As chassidim, listening and learning is only a preparation for our responsibility to be a lamplighter. We must teach and treat our children like the lights they truly are. We should look for opportunities to show them that they have the power to influence and impact their surroundings at home and in the world. Children aren't only a source of nachas, they are a source of inspiration and light. Children are teachers! Every Yid has a unique neshomo and has what to teach everyone. "From my students I've learned more than all"

As we enter into the final week of cheder, let's remind our children that as they go out into the world, they will be the powerful examples and give light in the potent way that Hashem meant it to be. Today is the last day of cheder for our Eighth Graders. With the steadfast foundation that they have received at cheder, may they go on to learning Torah with fervor and serving Hashem with thoughtful understanding and feeling and may their parents continue to have chassidishe nachas from them in good health and abundance.

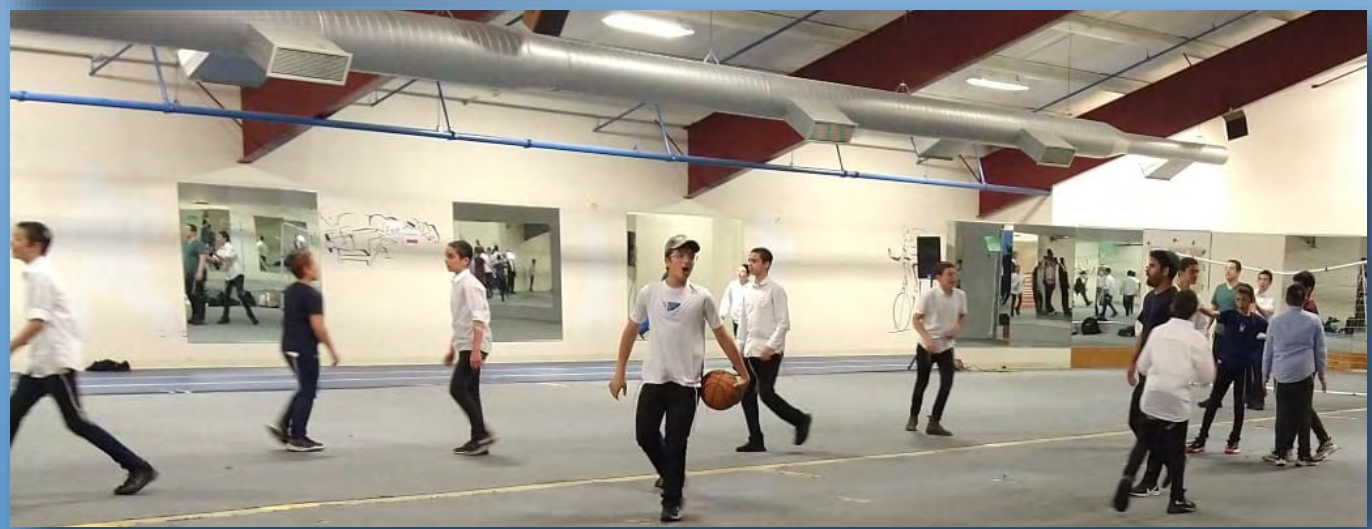
