## FROM *the* MENAHEL

Dear Parents,

In this week's parshah, Terumah, we learn about the construction of the Mishkan. Many pesukim are dedicated to describing the material, design and make up of the walls, curtains and coverings used for the building of the Mishkan.

It would seem the main keilim are those dedicated to the avodoh, the Shulchan and Aron. yet, many pesukim though are dedicated to discussing the design, artwork and craftsmanship invested in the walls and curtains.

There is an important message here that relates to chinuch as well. Zeh keili veanveihu, anything that is related to serving Hashem should be beautiful. Not only the essential elements of education, learning and davening should be at the highest level, but the chitzonios too, should be beautiful.

Scattered throughout the Rebbe's letters we find encouragement to parents, educators and publishers to beautify things related to kedushah. The Rebbe deliberately distributed crisp dollar bills, and requested that the booklets that were printed for him to distribute should be colorful and shiny. The Rebbe also encouraged the construction of beautiful chabad centers, and highlighted the message of chazal diranah marchiva dato shel odom.

Occasionally, we find an imbalance between the In the emphasis on beautiful gashmiyus, for the sake of gashmiyus and chinuch related things are neglected. In the chinuch of our children, we should keep in mind how important it is to beautify anything related to learning and kedushah emphasizing that it should be clean neat and nice.
