Lag Ba'omer will be on Sunday. There will be a grand parade at 770 in which we will want to participate. Considering the logistical challenges of going as a cheder, we will not have school. We will have a designated section for Cheder students, along with cheder staff to supervise the talmidim. Talmidim can be brought by their families, and dropped off at the designated area TBA as we get closer.

Dear Parents,

Pesach is here. The birth of our nation is marked by an immersive experience. Pesach requires all-out preparation and participation with all our might. Our limits are tested with staying awake, eating capacity, patience, and much more. We have many opportunities to generate memorable experiences.

Fulfilling all these mitzvos *behidur* for ourselves is a daunting task but we should keep in mind that the children are meant to be the central focus of the seder. We should consider ways to pique their interest and engage them as much as possible. Every child spanning from the אינו יודע should be engaged.

Please give your children the chance to present what they learned. Encourage them to participate throughout the seder and set your expectations high so they stretch to meet the bar set.

On several occasions, the Rebbe stressed that over Pesach, there is a unique opportunity to focus on learning. There are no *mivtza* campaigns available for *mivtzoim*, there is no mitzva to eat matzah, no Tefilin, etc. therefore the time should be used to learn Torah undisturbed.

Please bring along your children to shul and to minyonim throughout the yom tov, giving them the experience Yiddishkeit as part of a community, part of our nation. Please monitor their exposure to worldly matters and show them the unique Chabad approach to all aspects of Pesach.

The Alter Rebbe introduced a unique way to sell the chametz, which we follow to this day, this marks the first Chabad custom relating to Pesach. The final Chabad minhag is the Moshiach Seudah celebrated on the on the last day of Pesach, with 4 cups and special niggunim. This meal becomes the bridge between the holy and the mondain.
