LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

This week, we marked 60 years since the passing of Rebbetzin Chana, the Rebbe's mother. In retelling stories about her, I had the opportunity to highlight the many children at Cheder who are great-great-grandchildren of individuals who played a significant role in her life and in the events that unfolded around her passing.

Some of these great-grandchildren had no idea about their connection to ו' תשרי and Rebbetzin Chanah. This brings to mind the importance of sharing family traditions, history and connections with our children. Doing so, gives them a deep sense of belonging to our heritage. It doesn't have to be a Chabad connection, there are many other ways in which we can instill Jewish pride and connection in our children.

Some of us may descend from authors who wrote seforim or Jewish books, while others may have a tradition of being involved in *chesed*, building a shul or Yeshiva or other great Jewish cause to which they dedicated their life. It is impossible to list the many incredible things that Yidden are involved with, however, it is important for us to reflect upon what family traditions we should pass on to our children, the sacrifices they made, the values they lived and the examples they set for all Yidden and especially to their descendants.

As we approach Yom Kippur, please give your children the opportunity to show you what they learned either at the *seudah hamafsekes*, or at your breakfast meal. We may be hungry and exhausted, but our children needs us every day of the year.

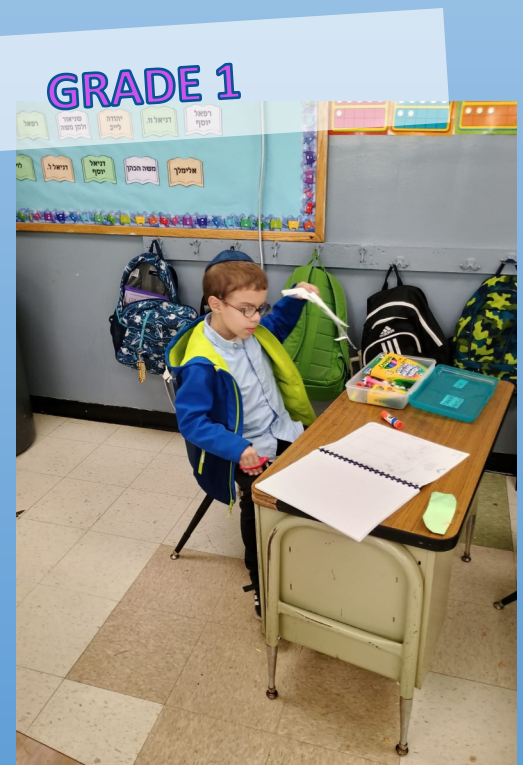
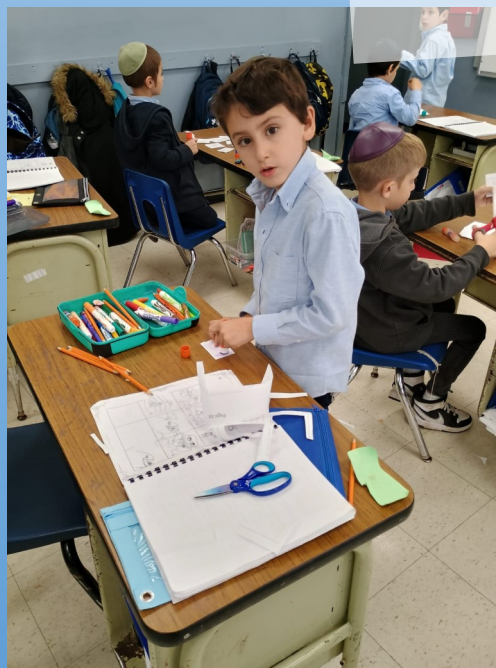
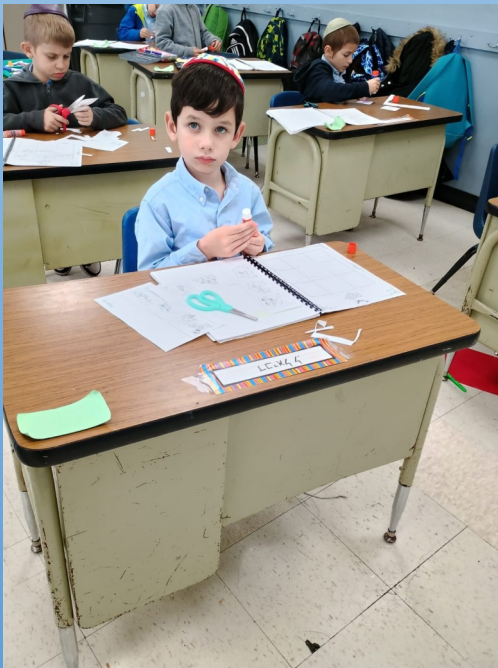


Peek at the Week

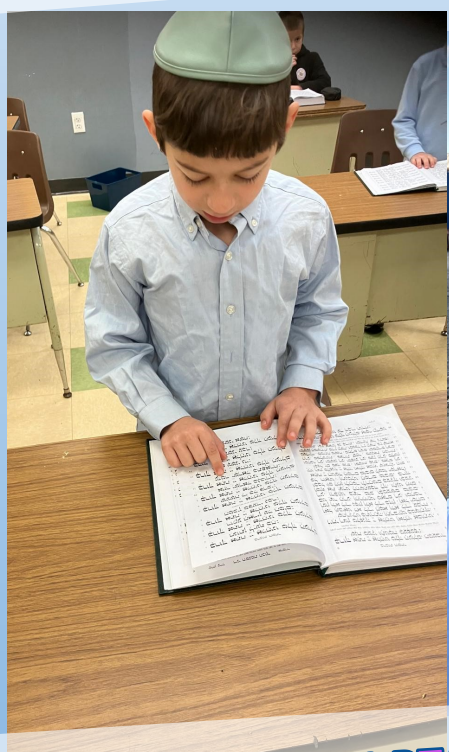
