LETTER FROM THE MENAHEL:

Dear Parents,

Yud Tes Kislev is known to us as the day that the Alter Rebbe was released from prison. It is also the Yahrtzeit of the Maggid, the Alter Rebbe's Rebbe. Every chosid marks this day be participating in a farbrengen and taking on *hachlotos* related to learning *chassidus* and adopting more *chassidic* practices.

It is rare for Yud Tes Kislev to fall out on Friday. This *kevius* allows you to invite your children to celebrate Rosh Hashonoh *lechassidus* with you. Please transform your shabbos meals into a farbrengen, have your son tell part of the Yud Tes Kislev story and encourage him to take on a *hachlotoh of a Chassidic nature*. Have him recite a section of Tanya that he knows by heart and take pride in his mastery of Tanya.

It is also valuable to include our children in community wide farbrengens. The ambiance of a large farbrengen may have a special impact on them. Especially seeing Yidden from outside communities who join us in marking Rosh Hashonoh *Lechassidus*.

We are the ones who make the day special and show our children that we cannot allow the day to just be ordinary.

We are looking forward to seeing many of the parents this Sunday as we continue the celebration of Yud Tes Kislev into Sunday with Father and Son Programs for Kitos Daled and up.

As the winter season is upon us, it was no surprise that we began the week with a two hour delay and additional snow to end the week. We learned that at the same time, it is Summer in the southern half of Earth, in Australia and S. Africa. The boys heard about animals that hibernate and migrate to get out of the cold and agreed that they would not waste their precious time sleeping in for so so long. The next topic in Math/Addition is using Arrays, which are groups of objects, pictures and numbers arranged in Rows (left to right) and Columns (top to bottom) to demonstrate Repeated Math as well as Multiplication. In Reading, Grandpa travelled with

his grandkids and did a great job keeping the peace between Blake and Milo by telling fish jokes. The fish keeps his money at the River Bank. The fish stays healthy by taking Vitamin Sea. This week is drawing to a close, and what a week we had! On Monday, Mrs. Jacobs taught us how to draw our own pattern of coats, as we made our own version of Yosef HaTazddik's Kesones Pasim. The boys also presented their different types of graphs, as they explained what type of graph they had made, what they were surveying, and who they asked. In Math, we learned about units of measurement, and we learned that the United States is one of the only countries in the world using the Imperial, and not the Metric system.
